2. MCEM to become a brand in the field of education.

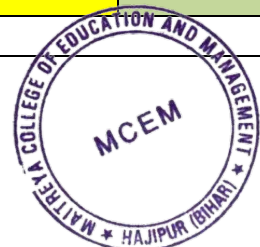
