Report on Seminar "Important Role of women in Nation Development"

The Co-ordinator, Principal and GB inaugurated on date 10th April 2018 of the programme by lightening the lamps. After that girl students of the college sang Rashtra Gaan and all the attendee stood up and sang with them. The Inaugural speech on the topic was delivered by the co-ordinator of Gender Sensitization Cell of Maitreya College of Education and Management Prof. (Dr.) Gyandeo Mani Tripathi, Principal of the college in his speech he spoke about the gender sensitization, where he explained that Gender sensitization refers to the modification of behaviour by raising awareness of gender equality concerns. "Gender sensitization is a weapon towards Gender Equity, Equal Opportunity and Women Empowerment which is essential for creating sustainable development as enshrined in our Constitution. The State & Central Government are making continuous efforts to realize these promises through Policies & Programs. The progress achieved in this direction has a mixed outcome and there is still long way to realize the objectives of the Equitable Society, Gender Equity and inclusive Development without discrimination which can be achieved bringing awareness among the people about the Rights given under the Constitution and the pro-women Acts and laws affecting women's right and empowerment in India. The Civil Societies are making efforts by pressing the Governments in power to address these issues. Commitment from the state to ensure women participation in Governance at all levels should be seen in action than in paper.

Prof. (Dr.) Gyandeo Mani Tripathi, further mentioned that keeping the objective in view the Gender Sensitization Cell has been formed in this college which will keep watchful eyes on maintaining Gender Equity.

The other speaker Asst. Prof. Ajay Kumar Singh delivered speech on the topic of the seminar "The Important Role of women in Nation Development".

Asst. Prof. Ajay Kumar Singh said that women play an important role in development of families, communities and nations. He recited a famous quote that "If you educate a man, you educate an individual; but if you educate a woman, you educate a family." He said that women constituting about 50 percent of the country's population, every effort have to be made to empower them economically, politically and in every other field.

Asst. Prof. Satyaprakash Mishra said that Indians have inherent talent and ability for entrepreneurship and emphasized on the need for state-of-the-art training and enhancement of skills. He said, "With

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






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rising demand for skilled personnel in various fields, more such training courses/programmes must be established in the college by signing MoU with industry and NGOs."

With the literacy rate of women touching about 65.46 percent in the country and rising steadily, Satyaprakash Mishra emphasized on the fact that studies have shown that increasing women and girls' education contributes to higher economic growth. He added that the major challenge is to increase women' participation in the country's workforce for faster economic growth.

The need is to train our students in trades such as electronics, architectural works, civil draughtsman ship, computer operator, programming assistant, secretarial practice, cosmetology, dress making, catering, hospitality, interior decoration and designing. He also reiterated his stance that College must also look into the possibility of imparting training in areas such as healthcare, travel and tourism industry, packaging and printing.

Five students of the college also expressed their views and emphasizes the importance of women' role in nation development. A student Chandani of B.Ed. Session 2017-19 said that just like women's invisible work in the household, women's work in community building and conflict resolution, which has significant human development implications, often goes unacknowledged. She named *Malala of Pakistan*, who fought for women' freedom. Further she took name of **Sampat Pal Devi** is an Indian social activist from the Bundelkhand region of Uttar Pradesh, North India. She is founder of the Gulabi Gang, an Uttar Pradesh-based social organisation, works for women welfare and empowerment. The following teachers and students attended this programme:

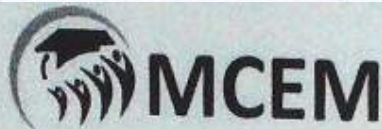

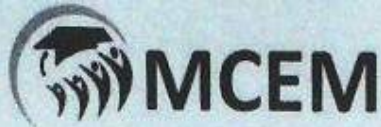

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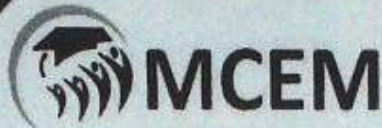

Report on Workshop "Youth and Democracy"

Maitreya College of Education and Management, Hajipur, Vaishali organized one day regional workshop on 12th January 2019 on Seminar Hall. The topic of the workshop was "Youth and Democracy" in a college. Most of the teaching staffs and students were present in the programme.

Trainee Rohit Kumar (709) Session 2018-20 from Giju Bhai House informed everyone about Swami Vivekananda's life and his thoughts. After this, registration of trainees was done for participation in the workshop. An exhibition titled "Life of Vivekananda and Youth of India – His Achievements" was organized. After that the vote of thanks was given by guest Raju Kumar Yadav from the organization "Grassroot Empowerment and development by youth".

Wreaths and lamps were lit on the photo of Swami Vivekananda by the guests, faculty members and trainees. Beautiful rendition of welcome song by Komal and Pooja Kumari. This was followed by an impressive lecture on the title "Role of Education and Democracy" by Satya Prakash Mishra, a faculty member of college.

He told that "Democracy is made up of two words Lok and Tantra, from which the word Lok is an indicator of the public and the word Tantra is an indicator of the system. That is, such a system of governance by which the public rules itself through its representatives. Further explaining the meaning of education, he said that the word education is derived from the root of Sanskrit language, education, which means learning and teaching. The famous sentence for this is 'Shismate Anen Iti Shiksha' which means that in which one learns, that is education. By the way, the word Vidya is also used for education, which is derived from Vid dhatu of Sanskrit language, which means to know. After this he said that India is a democratic country whose aim of education is also democratic. That is, a sensible, responsible, understanding of economic political activities has to be developed in the students. If the citizen of the country is not educated, he will be unable to understand the economic policies, then he will not approve the good economic policies of the government, due to which the government will face difficulties in making and implementing its economic and political policies and the country will not be able to progress. On this occasion, self composed poem was read by Krishna Mohan (714) session 2018-20 Krishnamurti Sadan.

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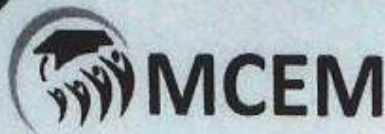

Trainee – Its pros and cons both terms what do you think.






4. If you are a true patriot, will you blame the government or not?

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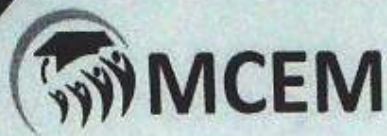

Report on Workshop "Gender Equality and Women' Empowerment in India"

The Gender Sensitization Cell of Maitreya College of Education and Management organized a one-day workshop for topic "Gender Equality and Women' Empowerment in India" on 20th February 2019 at 11:30 a.m. in the seminar hall of the College.

As a part of Inaugural Function a Group Song was presented by Girl Students of the college. Principal and Coordinator appreciated the participating girls.

The inaugural speech was delivered by Co-ordinator of Gender Sensitization Cell where he emphasized the importance of Gender Equity and Women Empowerment. In his speech he said that "Indian culture gives women the highest respect. Many of our gods are female and they have been worshipped as a goddess by many faithful people. The goddess of wealth is Laxmi, the goddess of power and strength is Durga and the goddess of Education is Saraswati. Women are the essence of wealth and power. Women play an important role in society and the whole family is dependent on women for its daily activities. They play the role of mother, wife, homemaker, cook, teacher, friend, Nurse all at the same time while catering to every body's needs. The women who are in a job have to also fulfill the job responsibilities while managing home & family. The life of women is very hard, but she gets little or no appreciation. There are a lot of women who are extremely talented & multitasked but have no recognition in society.

One of the major hindrances in the growth and advancement of women is gender inequality. This means that we treat males and females unequally even for the same task. This is generally in the case of rural societies. A male child is always encouraged by family to go to school, while the female child is told to learn household works.

As divorce is still a taboo in Indian society many women are suffering from abusive marriages. As they are not empowered, they fear to stand up for their right. If we want to empower women then domestic violence has to be stopped at any cost.

Other speaker Asst. Prof. Satyaprakash Mishra has explained in his speech that "The belief that men and women should have equal rights and opportunities and the theory of the political, economic and social equality of the sexes" is in theoretical practice but practical application is rarely seen. He further added:

- Gender inequality still exists in India within the households, workplaces and in larger society.

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






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- In certain developing nations like India, gender inequality starts manifesting itself very early a girl child starts facing discrimination right from the womb and it ends in female foeticide. Female child is treated inferior to male child and this is deeply engraved in the mind of the female child. This is more predominant in India as well as other lesser developed countries. A male child is considered a blessing and his birth is celebrated as opposed to a female child where her birth is not celebrated and is considered more of a burden.
- Educating a boy is seen as an investment as they are expected to earn and provide for their ageing parents. Whereas, an educated girl will have a higher dowry expense because they need an educated partner. If a family cannot afford to educate all their children, the male child will get preference.

One Student Miss Srishti Kumari also she said that education is an essential tool to empower women to gain confidence and achieve economic stability and success. Right to education is a fundamental right of all citizens under the 86th amendment of the Indian constitution, yet women's literacy is yet far behind males. The most significant difference is in the literacy rates of males and females in the rural areas fewer women are sent to school compared to the men. We all have to take initiatives in direction of achieving Gender Equity and Women Empowerment.

At the end Asst. Prof. Rekha Kumari thanked all the students, staff and guests of the college.

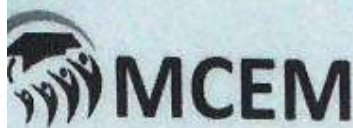
The Indian education system is mainly divided into four stages namely lower primary for the children between the age of six to ten years, upper primary with children from the age of eleven years to twelve years. High school, in which the children start their school at the age of 13 and end it at 16 and at the age of 17 to 18 they finish their higher secondary school.

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The other speaker Asst. Prof. Pavan Kumar Pandey delivered speech on the topic of the seminar "The New Education Policy in India". He further said that The Indian education system is considered to be the oldest among the education systems around the world. In spite of being the oldest, it is not the best. Lack of reforms and improvements makes the Indian education system ineffective and annoying.

From the beginning, the Indian education system is designed for a child to learn from the book and write exams just to get good grades. While it helps in improving the children's reading and writing ability, it does not help in learning the skills required to survive in the world.

We often hear on the news that unemployment in India is increasing day by day and in spite of many graduates having fancy degrees, many of them fail to land a job. So what is the reason for that? The answer is our Education system. The Indian education system is designed for students to score marks and get good grades and repeat the process but it was never designed to teach the students the skills required to survive in this world.

Asst. Prof. Hiralal Roy said that Indians have inherent talent and ability for entrepreneurship and emphasized on the need for state-of-the-art training and enhancement of skills. He said, "With rising demand for skilled personnel in various fields, more such training courses/programmes must be established in the college by signing MoU with industry and NGOs."

With the literacy rate of women touching about 65.46 per cent in the country and rising steadily, Asst. Prof. Raj Kumar Roy emphasized on the fact that studies have shown that increasing women and girls' education contributes to higher economic growth. He added that the major challenge is to increase women's participation in the country's workforce for faster economic growth.

The need is to train our students in trades such as electronics, architectural works, civil draughtsman ship, computer operator, programming assistant, secretarial practice, cosmetology, dress making, catering, hospitality, interior decoration and designing. He also reiterated his stance that College must also look into the possibility of imparting training in areas such as healthcare, travel and tourism industry, packaging and printing.

Many Speakers shared their views on the topic. One of the speaker said that "The vision of a self-reliant India is not possible without an empowered womanhood." She also talked about skill diversification and up gradation which can help women achieve success.

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














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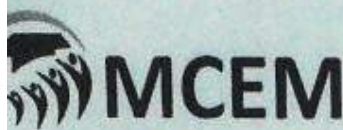

Report on "Dowry and Save Girl Child"

On 01st March 2021 at 11:00 A.M., the Gender Sensitization Cell of Maitreya College of Education & Management organized an Awareness Programme on the topic "Dowry and Save Girl Child".

The programme was inaugurated by Principal of the college. The Five boy and Five girl students sang Sarswati Vandana on this occasion.

Asst. Prof. Rekha Kumari, Coordinator of Gender Sensitization Cell explained the topic "Dowry and Save Girl Child". She said "Girls play multiple roles in the household, society and the economy. Keeping the rights of the girl child has seen increased support through the nearly global adoption of the Convention on the Rights of the Child, as well as through the UN Millennium Development Goals target of increasing equality between girls' and boys' educational attainment."

She added, Freedom from all forms of discrimination against the girl child remains only partly fulfilled, and governments and societies must induce efforts if true freedom is to be won. Policies and programmes initiated must be duty-bound to take into consideration the differing, yet critical, needs of the girl child in terms of physical protection from sexual and physical exploitation, discrimination in all forms including in the field of education, and increased awareness of the struggles being faced by girls today.

Gender Sensitization Cell has the duty to eliminate the discrimination for girl students in our college. They should be given respect and sense of security by boy students of the college. He asked the boy students to take oath that they will not receive any dowry and girls were also motivated to say NO to the Groom who asks for dowry.

Therefore, it is time to take effective steps against this social evil. It can be rooted out by generating public opinion against it. At the same time it is essential to pass strict laws for the exemplary punishment of the offenders. I hope, right thinking people will come forward to raise their voice against the Dowry System in India.

At the end, Asst. Prof. Rekha Kumari thanked all the students, staff and guests of the college.

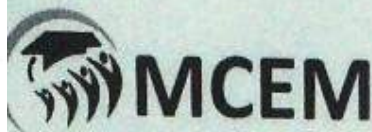

Report on workshop "HIV/AIDS Awareness Programme"

A workshop for Aids Awareness will be organized with topic "HIV/AIDS Awareness programme" on 1st December 2021 at 11:00 A.M.

The function was inaugurated by Chief Guest Mr. Harindra Kumar Singh Yadav, HOD, Royal Heritage College of Education by cutting the ribbon in Radhakrishnan Seminar Hall.

Mr. Yadav delivered the inaugural speech. He said एड्स (AIDS) एक ऐसी बीमारी जो इंसान को जीतेजी मरने पर विवश कर देती है। आज एड्स (AIDS) दुनियाभर में सबसे घातक बीमारी के रूप में उभरकर सामने आया है। यह एक ऐसी बीमारी है जिसका कोई इलाज नहीं है लेकिन ऐसा भी नहीं है कि इस बीमारी से बचा ही नहीं जा सकता। इस बीमारी का एकमात्र इलाज है बचाव।

"सावधानी हटी दुर्घटना घटी" यह शब्द एड्स (AIDS) की बीमारी के लिए बिलकुल प्रयुक्त साबित होते हैं। आजकल की भागदौड़ भरी जिंदगी और अनेकिक संबंधों की बाढ़ में यह बीमारी और भी तेजी से फैल रही है। सिर्फ असुरक्षित यौन संबंधों से ही नहीं यह बीमारी संक्रमित खून या संक्रमित इंजेक्शन की वजह से भी फैलता है। आज यह बीमारी पूरे विश्व के लिए एक सरदर्द बन चुकी है और यही वजह है कि संयुक्त राष्ट्र भी इस बीमारी को बेहद गंभीरता से लेता है और हर साल 01 दिसंबर को विश्व एड्स दिवस के रूप में मनाता है।

Principal Prof. (Dr.) Gyandeo Mani Tripathi delivered a very informative speech explaining cause, tests, symptoms and remedies : एड्स का पूरा नाम 'एक्वायर्ड इम्यूनो डेफिसिएंसी सिंड्रोम' है और यह बीमारी एच.आई.वी. वायरस से होती है। यह वायरस मनुष्य की प्रतिरोधी क्षमता को कमजोर कर देता है। एड्स एच.आई.वी. पाजीटिव गर्भवती महिला से उसके बच्चे को, असुरक्षित यौन संबंध से या संक्रमित रक्त या संक्रमित सूई के प्रयोग से हो सकता है। एचआईवी से संक्रमित व्यक्ति के साथ असुरक्षित संभोग करना इस मर्ज के प्रसार का एक प्रमुख कारण है। ऐसे संबंध समलैंगिक भी हो सकते हैं।

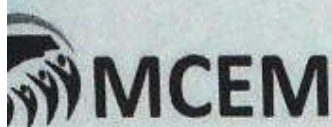
He also explained other causes of AIDS.

- * **Blood Transfusion:** ब्लड-ट्रांसफ्यूजन के दौरान शरीर में एच.आई.वी. संक्रमित रक्त के चढ़ाए जाने पर।
- * **Infected Injection:** एचआईवी पाजीटिव व्यक्ति पर इस्तेमाल की गई इंजेक्शन की सूई का इस्तेमाल करने से।
- * एचआईवी पाजीटिव महिला की गर्भावस्था या प्रसव के दौरान या फिर स्तनपान कराने से भी नवजात शिशु को यह मर्ज हो सकता है।
- * इसके अलावा रक्त या शरीर के अत्य द्रव्यों जैसे वीर्य के एक दूसरे में मिल जाने से, दूसरे लोगों के ब्लेड, उस्तरा और दूध ब्रश का इस्तेमाल करने से भी एचआईवी का खतरा रहता है।

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होने पर मरीज का वजन अचानक कम होने लगता है और लंबे समय तक बुखार हो सकता है। काफी समय तक रिया बना रह सकता है। शरीर में गिल्टियों का बढ़ जाना व जीभ पर भी काफी जख्म आदि हो सकते हैं।

A student in her speech emphasized on importance of awareness towards AIDS. She said : स के प्रसार से लड़ने का एकमात्र तरीका है, और वो है लोगों में जागरूकता उत्पन्न करना। एचआईवी के त्नांतरण का कारण है लापरवाही या नजरअंदाज करना। जिस वजह से यह बुरी स्थिति को और भी बदतर बना है। इसलिए, यह जरूरी है कि लोगों को पता चले कि एड्स क्या है, यह कैसे फैलता है और संक्रमण को रोकने लिए क्या किया जा सकता है।











लेकिन लोगों को प्रसन्न नहीं होना चाहिए न हीं भूलना चाहिए की एड्स अभी भी घातक बीमारियों में से एक है, जिससे इन्सान की मृत्यु हो सकती है। विभिन्न जागरूकता पहलुओं का आयोजन किया गया है। जिनमें से सबसे प्रमुख विश्व एड्स दिवस है - इस दिन लोग उन लोगों के साथ एकजुटता दिखाते हैं जो लोग इस बीमारी से पीड़ित हैं और उन लोगों को याद करते हैं जिनकी इस बीमारी के वजह से मृत्यु हुई है। अगला लक्ष्य है कमजोर लोगों और समुदायों को जागरूक करना, ताकि वे पूरी तरह से सूचित हो सकें और बीमारी को फैलने से रोक सकें।

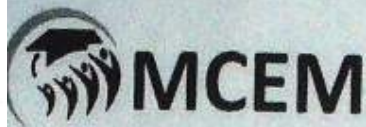
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

Report on workshop "Role of Quality and Accreditation"

Maitreya College of Education and Management, Hajipur, Vaishali organized a workshop on 07th February 2022. The topic of the workshop was "Role of Quality and Accreditation" in a college. Most of the teaching staffs and students were present in the programme.

The workshop was inaugurated by Principal, Prof. (Dr.) Gyandeo Mani Tripathi, Asst. Prof. Rekha Kumari, Asst. Prof. Raj Kumar Roy with lightening the lamps.

The inaugural speech was delivered by the Asst. Prof. Raj Kumar Roy. He threw light on the importance of **Quality and Accreditation**. In his speech he said that in today's fast changing world, quality education has become a universal goal where university education should aim at the formation of personalities and intellectual abilities of the graduates and their continuing education and must not be regarded solely as a means of providing them with diplomas and entry tickets to the job market. To aspire to higher standards of educational quality is no longer a luxury. Quality assurance is in most cases encouraged by continuous self-assessment and by seeking some form of internal or sometimes external validation or accreditation. He further added that "Internal Quality Assurance Cell is formed in the college to achieve the goal of Quality and Accreditation which cannot be procured without help and co-operation of GB members, staff and students of the college".

Asst. Prof. Rekha Kumari addressed the audience and explained his views about Quality and Accreditation where she mentioned that Quality is no longer perceived as an institutional internal matter but as one which is of concern to various stakeholders both internally and externally. The existence of Quality Assurance (QA) system establishes a sense of accountability and clarifies the roles and responsibilities of providers of higher education. Generally, accreditation is important to higher education institution as it:

1. Helps advance standards and promote excellence,
2. Provides means for on-going self-assessment and continuous improvement,
3. Enhances reputation and creates public accountability,
4. Supports the obtainment of financial aid and support and the establishment of international cooperation,
5. Helps students determine acceptable institutions to pursue their education,
6. Assists institutions in determining acceptability of transfer credits,

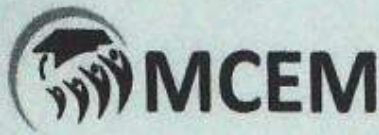
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






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- Helps employers determine the validity of programs of study and whether a graduate is qualified.

Guest Speaker, Professor, Sushil Kumar Singh also addressed the attendee at this occasion, he told that Qualitative improvement in higher education, to realize the desired dimensions of human resource development necessitated the establishment of the premier Quality Assurance Agency – NAAC – by the UGC, in 1994, to assess and accredit the country's Higher Education Institutions. He further added that Quality assurance is not an event! It is a continuous process and a relentless pursuit to achieve academic excellence. As the primary goal of institutional accreditation by NAAC is to provide the information needed to improve the experience of the 'learning communities', it is envisaged that NAAC plays a larger role in internalizing and institutionalizing quality assurance.

Report on workshop "The New Education Policy in India"

Maitreya College of Education and Management, Hajipur has organized a one day Seminar on 27th November 2020. The Topic of the workshop was **"The New Education Policy in India"**. The following members from teaching and non-teaching staff attended the seminar. The co-ordinator, Principal and Manger, GB inaugurated the programme by lightening the lamps. The Inaugural speech on the topic was delivered by the Principal on New Education Policy in India of Maitreya College of Education and Management, Hajipur.

Prof. Gyandeo Mani Tripathi, Principal of the college In his speech he spoke about the Education Policy, where he explained that Education Policy refers to the modification of behaviour by raising awareness of Education Policy concerns. Education is a process of learning or teaching new skills or knowledge. Education is mostly provided in schools and universities. Education is very important for the development of the country. It helps in the economic development of the country. Education can change the life of a person. Former president of India Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam is the best example of how education can change the life of a person. Education if provided properly can change the perspective of people. Here we have provided a long and short speech on the education system in India and along with that we have also given 10 line pointers about the speech on the education system.

Prof. Gyandeo Mani Tripathi further mentioned that keeping the objective in view Good morning to everyone present here. Today I am going to give a small speech on the education system in India. I hope you all learn new things from this speech.

Education is defined as the process of receiving or giving primary knowledge, especially at the school or university level. Education is a significant factor that helps in improving the literacy rate of the country. After Independence, the Indian government has mainly focused on providing education to everyone and for years the government has introduced new plans to improve Indian education.

The Indian education system is mainly divided into four stages namely lower primary for the children between the age of six to ten years, upper primary with children from the age of eleven years to twelve years. High school, in which the children start their school at the age of 13 and end it at 16 and at the age of 17 to 18 they finish their higher secondary school.

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The other speaker Asst. Prof. Pavan Kumar Panday delivered speech on the topic of the seminar "The New Education Policy in India". He further said that The Indian education system is considered to be the oldest among the education systems around the world. In spite of being the oldest, it is not the best. Lack of reforms and improvements makes the Indian education system ineffective and annoying.

From the beginning, the Indian education system is designed for a child to learn from the book and write exams just to get good grades. While it helps in improving the children's reading and writing ability, it does not help in learning the skills required to survive in the world.

We often hear on the news that unemployment in India is increasing day by day and in spite of many graduates having fancy degrees, many of them fail to land a job. So what is the reason for that? The answer is our Education system. The Indian education system is designed for students to score marks and get good grades and repeat the process but it was never designed to teach the students the skills required to survive in this world.

Asst. Prof. Hiralal Roy said that Indians have inherent talent and ability for entrepreneurship and emphasized on the need for state-of-the-art training and enhancement of skills. He said, "With rising demand for skilled personnel in various fields, more such training courses/programmes must be established in the college by signing MoU with industry and NGOs."

With the literacy rate of women touching about 65.46 per cent in the country and rising steadily, Asst. Prof. Raj Kumar Roy emphasized on the fact that studies have shown that increasing women and girls' education contributes to higher economic growth. He added that the major challenge is to increase women' participation in the country's workforce for faster economic growth.

The need is to train our students in trades such as electronics, architectural works, civil draughtsman ship, computer operator, programming assistant, secretarial practice, cosmetology, dress making, catering, hospitality, interior decoration and designing. He also reiterated his stance that College must also look into the possibility of imparting training in areas such as healthcare, travel and tourism industry, packaging and printing.

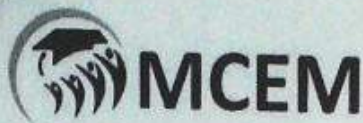

Report on Seminar "Prithivi ka bikarta parivesh, Ek Vimarsh"












Reports on Seminar "Policies on Gender based issues"

Report on the Workshop of "Awareness and Impact of Make in India"

On 05th August 2019, Maitreya College of Education and Management has organized a one-day workshop in the premises of college. A large number of students and teachers participated in this workshop. The Topic of the Workshop was **"Awareness and Impact of Make in India"**.

The programme was inaugurated by Principal of the college. The Co-ordinator of different cells and its committee members were also present on the occasion.

Asst. Prof. Raj Kumar Roy put light on the topic in his speech said that "The slogan clearly points to the government's aim to make India a global manufacturing hub. It is a fact that Manufacturing contributes only 15% to India's GDP and the government wants to raise it to 25%. Asst. Prof. Ajay Further said that to serve the purpose the government has identified 25 key sectors, which include: automobiles, auto components, bio-technology, chemicals, defence, manufacturing, electronic systems, food processing, leather, mining, oil and gas, ports, railways, ports and textile. Now youth of country is to contribute in government's mission and for that they have to be skilled enough to be a soldier to win the motto "MAKE IN INDIA".

Asst. Prof. Rekha Kumari spoke about the impact of "MAKE IN INDIA". He described that *"Under the Make in India programme, indigenous manufacturing is expected to increase by 12-14% per annum over the medium term. As per the World Bank, manufacturing contributed about 16% to the country's GDP in 2016"* So it has become important for our students to be aware about the importance of MAKE IN INDIA mission.

One of the students of the college said that India's population is expected to become the world's youngest; more than 500 million Indian citizens will be under 25 years of age and more than two thirds of the population will be eligible to work. This means that a growing number of India's youth need the right educational infrastructure to develop skills and adequate opportunities to get employed or become entrepreneurs. However, the wide gap between those who have access to education and skill development opportunities and those who do not, is a challenge that has to be overcome. 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
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Dependent. We students have the duty to be aware about the policies/scheme of the Govt. which aims at Skill Development to get benefitted to start a business of our own.

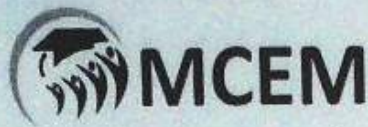

- The program not only wishes for employment but also strives to broaden the mindset of the youth. For actual progress, we need good entrepreneurship and skill.

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












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- It also has provisions for the economic empowerment of the underprivileged youth such as skill loan scheme and aims to lessen poverty.
